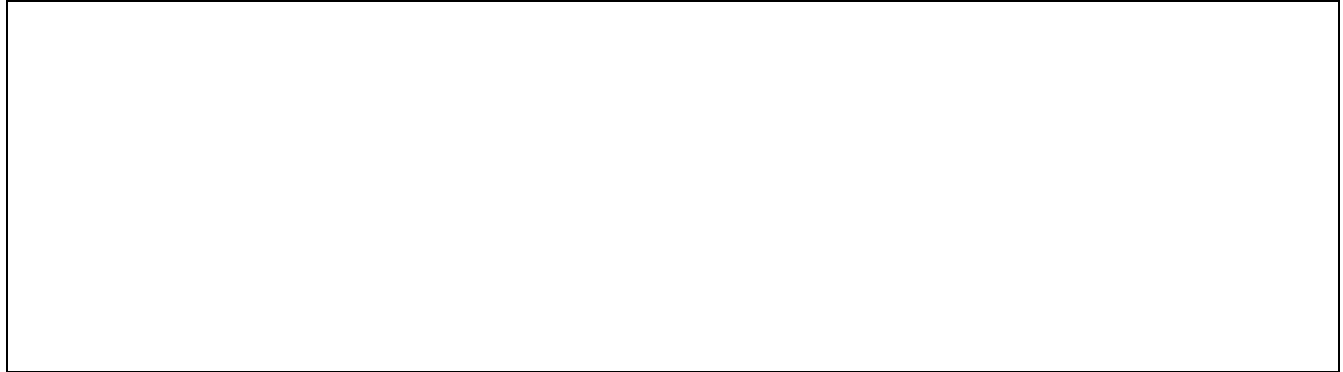


The Dough Guy
