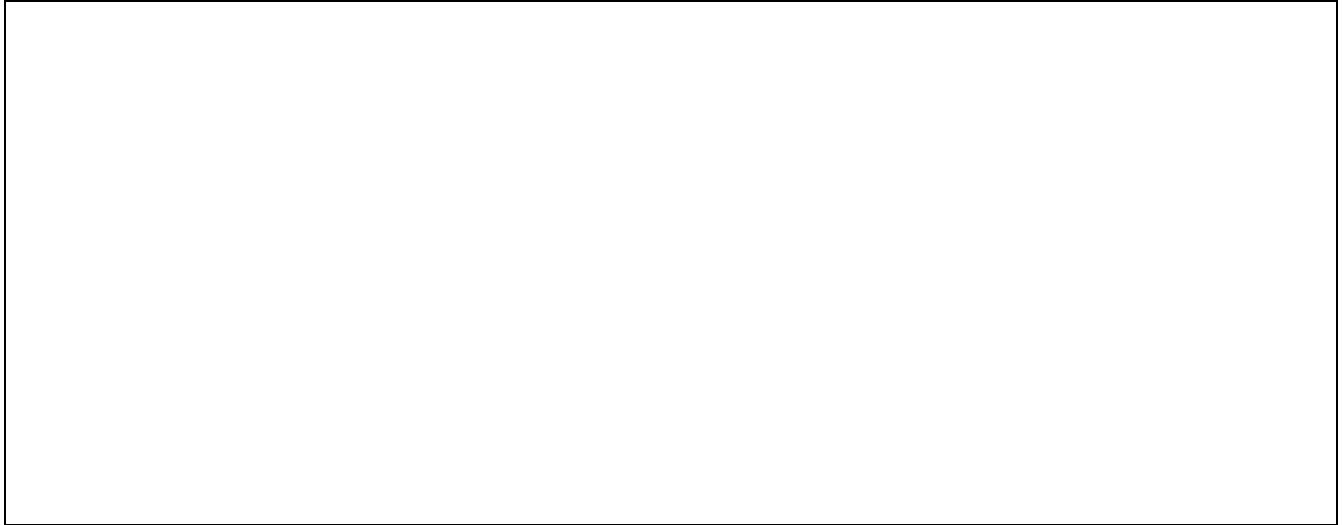


The Ship Dock
