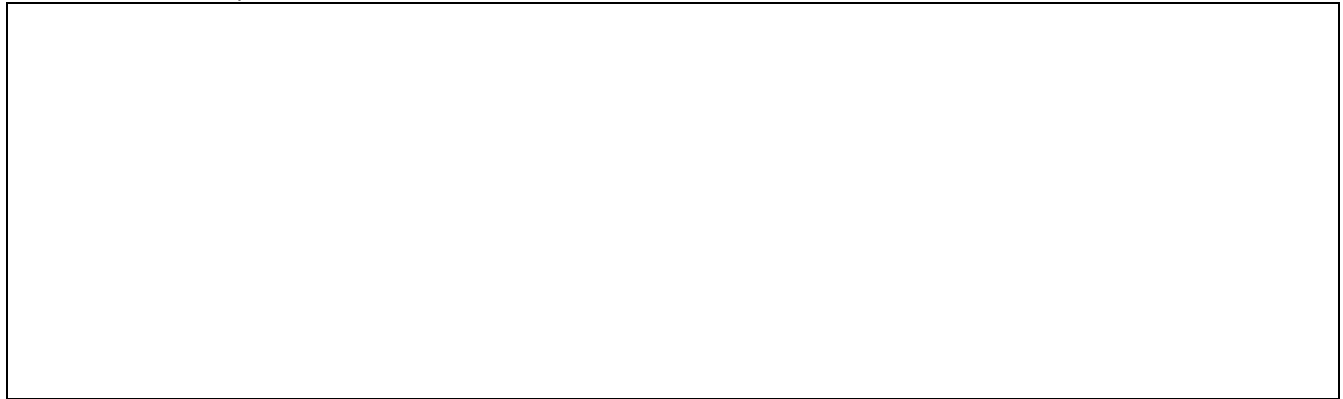


A New Coin
